In Charles Garrad's *Inside Out*, the simple act of painting on a window-pane effects a magical dissolve between interior and exterior space ► Susan Derges' Hermetica reveals a direct relationship between sound and image within the natural world. A droplet of mercury. reflecting the lens of the video camera, vibrates to sine-waves of increasing frequency.
