an installation for three monitors

1980

starting with a visual device: a sailboat, flanked by two beaches (or the same beach perceived at different instances) vainly aspires to a passage between them. A movement, continuous, but continuously frustrated by the relentless framing function of the camera/monitor screen.

THEN

the passage ultimately is of the screen: a metaphoric elaboration of the scanning rhythm fundamental to the video process, or to the reading of a text; it is our desperate dependence on a narrative structure which fabricates the situation.

AND THEN

the grasping of memory: the yearning for movement. Instrument and anchor.
