THE FALLACY OF THE UNDISTRIBUTED MIDDLE and other videotapes

Steve Hawley will present several of his 'shorts' with a discussion.

I wish I'd invented Star Trek's Mr. Spock, because he embodies what these videotapes are all about. The venusian half of him predominates most of the time ( "logically captain, your fear of death is completely irrational" ) but occasionally, like every episode, his human half breaks through, and he fails in love or goes crackers or whatever. The opposition between reason and emotion seems forever unresolved. In the 'Undistributed Middle' a person (me actually) walks around his living room constructing a number of informal and syllogistic arguments which all contain fallacies. But none of the conclusions painstakingly arrived at are really verifiable by logic. Other of these half dozen tapes examine similar things things from a different angle; they are all SHORT, and a few incorporate music, some composed on the editting bench
