Conversation between JOHN LOGIE-BAIRD, (JLB Voice over) and STOOKY BILL (SB in vision) at the point where JLB achieves the first TV transmission with a recognisable image.

- JLB This is it..... This is it!... I've got it at last...

  The first ever.....!
- SB Aye the first living pictures from the blue.
- JLB This is a great day for me!
- SB And it's a great day for me.
- JLB I can scarcely believe my eyes.

- JLB Aye, they'll want nothing else.
- SB What a waste of time!
- JLB Maybe, but they'll want to see more of themselves than ever before.....they'll give time to that
- SB But.....if they think this is really doing that...they'll believe anything...
- JLB Well...put like that, maybe.....
- SB Then they'll believe in me Johnnie?
- JLB Well....I just suppose they might Bill.
- SB And I'll be much, much easier to get along with....
- JLB Aye...that may be so...
- SB ...And I'll show them a world they've never seen before.
- JLB Oh? How?
- SB I'll perform a lot of tricks.... and they'll take it all to be their own
- JLB But it won't be theirs....that'll be cheating Bill
- SB Oh, they'll not see it like that, and mine'll be much more attractive....Aye....I'll be all in the future
- JLB Aw....you're a fantastical little dummy....You'll have to convince
   a lot of people
