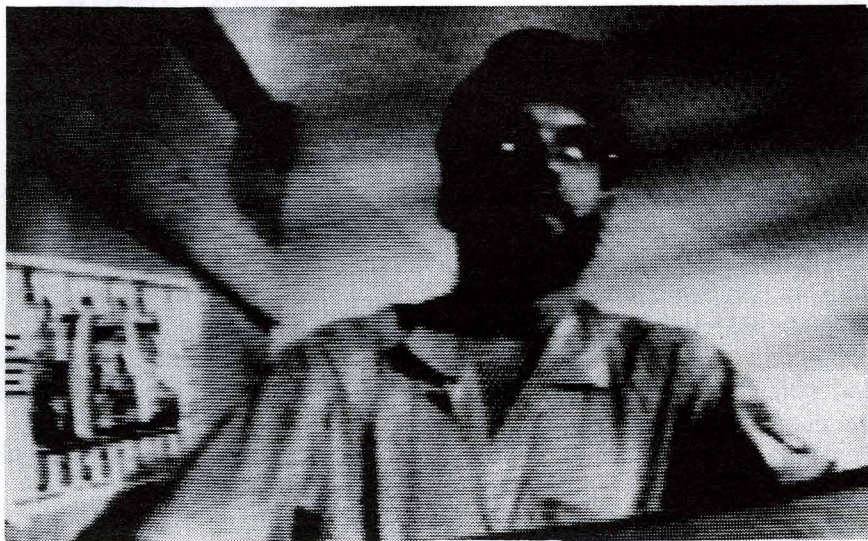

Their plans change when the car, which they bought for the trip, breaks down and Jay, an ex-computer game designer offers them a ride. He wants to make his own film about the couple and they agree. On their drive, Ken and Jane win \$100,000 in Reno. Meanwhile, Jane's best friend Diane lands a job on a right-wing pirate TV station run by Sam Heart (Hitler with a truckers cap) and his wife Jean ('the little woman'). By the time Ken and Jane return to the East Coast, Jay (who is lying in a hospital bed in L.A.) is haunted by fears that the couple is growing apart. During this time of crisis in their relationship, a failed political talk show host and a blind magician keep Ken company, while Jane stays home with a computer.
