- 3. Track 180 270' at eye level in backwards and forwards movements thru the entire sequence, again picks up a further 'woman with a video camera'
- 4. Track 270 360', at a high level, looking down on the square and cutting out the boring background; including passing glances of various extras, both in and out of costume, in walking, running and rushing movements ? At the end, the camera drops to eye level and picks up the 'Woman with the video camera'
