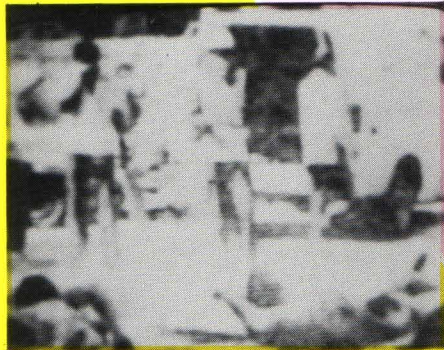

- Video has become part of our daily diet and risks losing its potency as a radical tool. Early video culture grasped the opportunity of proposing alternatives, of questioning existing structures. Modernism is being drowned. Where is the oppositional practice? My early work concentrated on a search for a language specific to the medium and used landscape as a means of relating process to subject matter. Since 1977, when I started working on the *Vanitas* project, I have looked to history for ways of identifying codes and metaphors for translating ideas of representation.

In the most recent installation work I have been looking at the way in which history is presented through 'an official view' disregarding the fact that history is constructed and is largely distorted by the presence of cultural domination.
