'PAST IMPERFECT' MARC CAMILLE CHAIMOWICZ

Reflective and evocative in nature,
Marc Chaimowicz's work reveals a continuing
concern with memory, the past, a 'temporary truce
between the ideal and the real'. This exhibition
looks at aspects of his work over the past ten years
— documenting performances, installations and
video pieces — and presenting a selection of
objects: a free standing screen, a 'desk on decline',
series of 'Studies' incorporating photographs and
painted decoration, and maquettes for furniture
pieces. Artwork from his book project will also be
shown. A specially produced book on
Chaimowicz's work is being published to coincide
with this exhibition.
