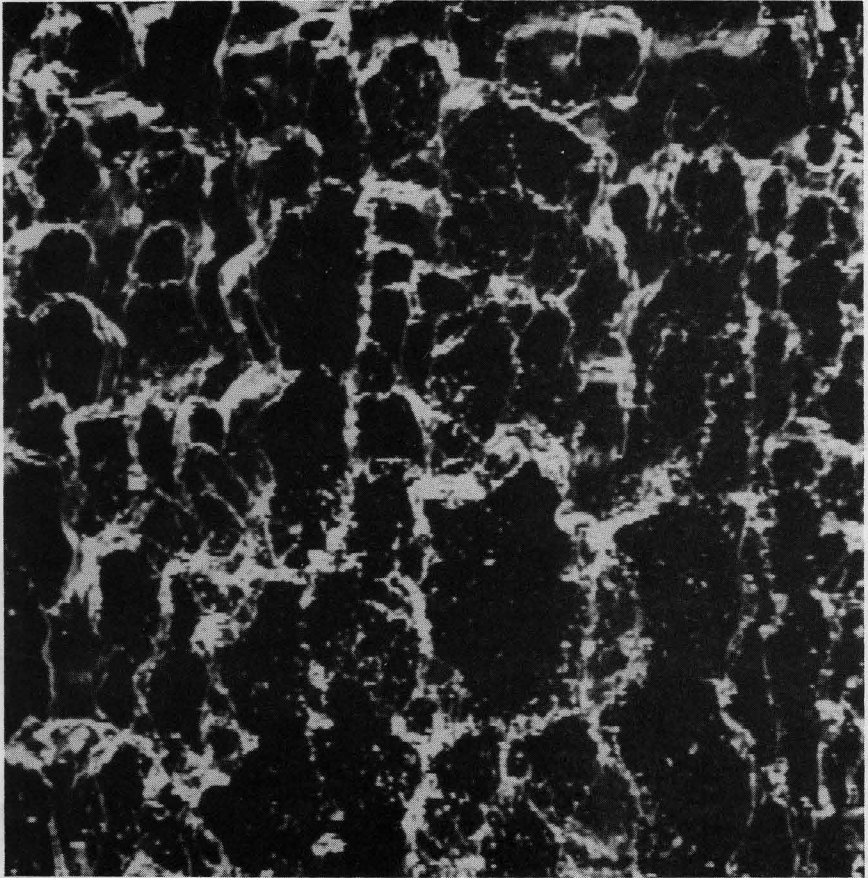

Judith Goddard is one of Britain's best known video artists. Consisting of two parts, this work is about fire and water. In one space, a Wimhurst machine creates an electric spark, before a large-scale film of a waterfall. In another space a drip of water is seen under a strobe light and appears to drip upwards. Rooted in alchemy, this will be the first showing of a remarkable installation and is a departure for Goddard. The work will subsequently be included in a major exhibition of video art in Lisbon next year as part of Lisbon European City of Culture. A catalogue will subsequently be produced.

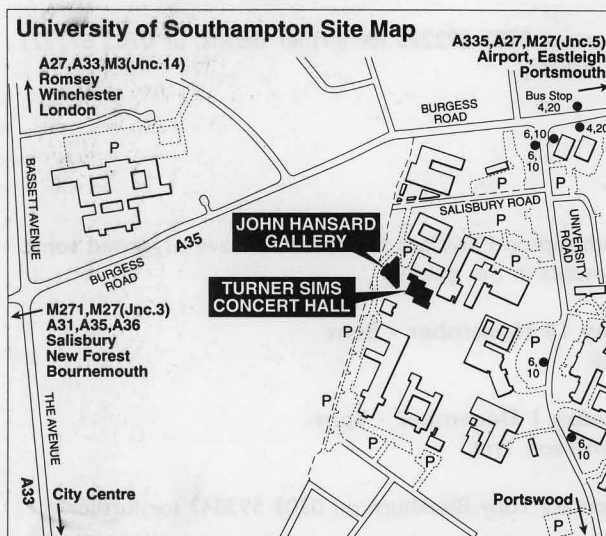
JULIAN GRATER - SCATTERING OF DUST

18 January - 26 February 1994

Julian Grater won a McColl Arts Foundation bursary with which he spent six months as artist in residence at the Tom Price Iron Ore Mine in the Pilbara Region of Western Australia. The resulting paintings and drawings combine the mythology and geography of the region, using ores from the mine as pigments which perfectly capture the visual feel of the area. The exhibition has been organised by Pratt Contemporary Art in collaboration with John Hansard Gallery, and will subsequently tour to Wolverhampton Museum and Art Gallery, Harris Museum, Preston and the Royal Cornwall Museum Truro. A catalogue is being produced to accompany the exhibition.
